TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

The Old Town Lewisville “42” Open is a double-elimination tournament, meaning a team must lose twice before being eliminated. Matches are won by the first team to capture two seven-point games. Early rounds may be placed on a time limit if officials determine it is required to accommodate the volume of entries.

Players submitting an entry as a team will be paired with their registered partner. Players submitting an individual entry will be matched with a partner by random draw and will remain paired with the partner for the duration of the tournament.

A table marshal will be assigned to each grouping of five (or fewer) tables and will oversee play at those tables, resolving any disputes that might arise and enforcing the game and tournament rules.

A tournament marshal will be assigned to overall all game play, addressing any appeals of table marshal decisions and enforcing all tournament rules. Rulings by the tournament marshal will be considered final.

A copy of rules of play for the tournament will be provided to any players who pre-register, or can be picked up at the tournament site the morning of Saturday, Sept. 4.
